1. When is the evaluation period for KentuckyOne?

This evaluation period runs July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2014. Appraisals are August 15, 2014.

2. Why have the evaluations changed?

The evaluation tool has changed for a couple of reasons. As we continue organization, so do our leaders. Many of our leaders are responsible for staff locations. To simplify the appraisal process, we created a standard evaluation tool.

3. Who should I evaluate?

- You should evaluate employees who were hired on or before March 31
- Please complete a 90-day introductory evaluation for employees hired
- You do not need to complete an annual appraisal for employees who introductory evaluation in April, May or June 2014.

4. The evaluation tool does not have a section for our competency-based age/population-specific competencies. Are those still required?

Yes. You will continue to evaluate competency-based and/or age/population-competencies on a separate form and document that it has been completed. the box on the evaluation tool to indicate the competency evaluations were complete competency document should be maintained in the department file. need to submit a copy with the evaluation tool.

5. The evaluation tool does not have a section for values-based behaviors. expected to incorporate them somehow?

KentuckyOne's values-behavior guidelines reinforce our commitment to Integrity, Compassion and Excellence. The guidelines range from "keep the and safe" to "foster an environment of patient/family engagement and care/treatment." The basic structure of a tag question is: positive statement negative tag Snow is white, isn't it? The tag repeats the main verb. You forget your birthday, didn't you? I can come, can't I? They will help, wo n't they? With rising intonation, it sounds like a real question. Sohrah was a brave man, wasn't he? The mother rose in her, didn't it? Answering Tag Questions How do we answer a tag question? negative statement positive tag You don't like me, do you? No it isn't! Answer is same in both cases - because snow is not black! Snow isn't black, is it? A true patriot is honored by all, isn't he? Bangladesh is a democratic country, isn't she? Be very careful about answering tag questions. Look at these examples: positive statement treated as negative statement positive tag He never came again, did he? Yes, it does. He's got a prize, hasn't he? I am just hopeless at telling jokes, aren't I? Remember that in Present Simple, do is optional in positive statements (You like coffee/You do like coffee). Nobody knows, do they? This is the wrong answer in English! Here are some more examples, with correct answers: The moon goes round the earth, doesn't it? What a pity!, isn't it? Let him do the work, will you? Let them do their work, will you? The universities have opened recently, haven't they? You won't be late, will you? Some chance! So you think that's funny, do you? The earth is round, isn't she? You won't eat it, will you? Most of you know French, don't you? They will not go to school, will they? John was there, was n't he? aren't I (not amn't I) You have to go, don't you? Notice: the use of do in the two coffee questions. I barely know you, do I? Open the door, will you? I'd meet you, wouldn't I? He never goes out with his dog, does he? People of all ages enjoy the game, don't they? You do n't like coffee, do you? Don't boil rice, will you? Nothing comes out of nothing, does it? This can lead to a lot of confusion! Answer a tag question according to the truth of the situation. How sweetly the bird sings, doesn't it? Negative-negative tag questions usually sound rather hostile: So you don't like my looks, don't you? Positive Statement Tag Questions Look at these examples with positive statements. The moon shines at night, doesn't it? Don't forget, will you? We use can, can't, will, would for orders. That's wonderful! She wants to marry him, does she? He as well as his friends has done the work, hasn't he? Let's do the work, shall we? Patriotism inspires a man to shed the last drop of blood to defend the freedom of his country, doesn't it? We use tag questions to ask for confirmation, less polite Don't forget, will you. You should obey your teachers, shouldn't you? quite polite Do it now, will you. Some more special cases example notes I am right, aren't I? Think again. There were many problems, weren't there? Yes. The same applies to Past Simple did. Notice that some are "normal" and others seem to break all the rules: But you don't really love her, do you? Notice that the negative verb in the original statement is changed to positive in the tag. For the boys the task was easy, wasn't it? No, they don't! Men don't have babies, do they? We didn't play very well today, did we? Bangladesh cricket team won the match over Sri Lanka, didn't they?
